REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO INFOSYS, MYSURU

Write up on the event:

An industrial visit was organized on 1st April, 2023 to Infosys campus, Mysuru for the MBA students with 4 faculty members of PG Department. Students left the college at 7:30 AM. They were split into 2 buses which had 2 faculty members in each to volunteer for the journey. They had stopped for breakfast at Bangalore-Mysore National Highway, and continued with their journey to Mysore. They also enjoyed the journey dancing and singing songs. Students reached Infosys at 12:30 PM. They were asked to show their Aadhar ID at the entrance and were assembled at the gate and each was numbered for the count. They were then guided by Mr Keerthiraj. He took the students to the entrance of the training centre and then to the seminar hall. They gave some introduction about the company and shared some glimpses of Infosys and structure through . They had cleared some of the questions raised by students and they also gave detailed information in career development in Infosys and the process of recruitment that is

Once the seminar was done students were able to explore all the magnificent infrastructures like the gym, pool and amphitheatre. The unique feature which caught the attention for all is they had named every plant in their scientific name followed by the person who planted it. It was pleasing to eyes to watch the nature and the degree of cleanliness maintained in the campus. The students then captured group pictures which were memorable. It represented a miniature of a city which was made accessible for all the facilities like banking, shopping, hospital, library, athletic tracks.
